Transportation & Gas Assistance Programs in Wayne County

City of Wooster Transportation Program

330.264.8677 managed by Community Action of Wayne / Medina

Enrollment offers access to the Fixed Route with 21 stops looping around the city and Subsidized Trip Passes, which can be used to book a ride within city limits with certain providers. This service is available to residents within the Wooster city limits who meet any of the following criteria: elderly (62+), disabled, veteran, or low-income (under 200% of the federal poverty level).

Medical-Specific Transportation Providers

 - Provides free transportation for patients to Wooster Community Hospital and over 50 medical offices where the providers are part of the hospital's current medical staff, including Cleveland Clinics, Akron Children's, and more.

 - Provides free transportation for patients to Aultman Orrville Hospital. The pickup location must be within a 25-mile radius of Aultman Orrville Hospital.

 - Provides free Transportation to medical appointments at VA medical facilities in Cleveland, Parma, and Canton for veterans living in Wayne County.

For example, the Healthy Aging grant allows individuals aged 60 and over who earn less than \$3,700 per month free rides. Wheelchair accessible.

Gas Assistance Programs

- **JFS PRC Program 330.287.5812**
 - Prevention, Retention, and Contingency [PRC] is a statewide program administered by Wayne County Department of Job and Family Services. Work supports available vary by county and may include, but are not limited to, transportation, auto repairs, license tags, and gasoline. Only for those within the first 4 months of employment.
- **JFS Non-Emergency Transportation Program 330.287.5841**
 - Non-Emergency Transportation Program [NET] is a statewide program administered by Wayne County Department of Job and Family Services. This program can provide transportation assistance to eligible individuals going to and from Medicaid-approved appointments by providing gas vouchers for current Medicaid recipients. The Medicaid Transportation Coordinator can also help you learn about other ways your Medicaid health insurance may provide transportation assistance, including scheduling rides through partnered providers.
