Child & Family Development

Head Start Program

Promoting social, emotional, intellectual, and physical development through health, nutrition, mental health, developmentally appropriate education, social services, and preschool special education.

Early Head Start

Home-based services that promote parents as primary educators of their children by providing tools toenhance their role from preganancy to kindergarten.

Community Access

CAWM operates 8 head start centers (Wooster, West Salem, Rittman, Orrville, Medina, Wadsworth, Brunswick, and Lodi (Fall 2023)

Socialization & Safety
